
and contact other Field Day Stations.


Tour of the Rio Grande Valley is returning September 18, 2011.

PowerPole Opportunity

Been wanting to install PowerPole connectors on your rig's power cable and on your power supply, battery charger, mobile power, wire to alligator clamps, wire to cigarette lighter plug, etc? Field Day will be an opportunity to do that. Ralph (NM5RC) will be bringing box of connectors and crimper tool so you can do that. For those not familiar with PowerPole connectors, they are genderless 12-V plugs (think of an extension cord with connectors so either end can be plugged into your radio or power supply) and are the ARES/RACES standard for Amateur Radio equipment. All Ralph asks is a contribution towards the actual cost of the connectors.
