#### ARRL Field Day 2011 Results

ARRL has released the database for rankings of club stations for Field Day 2011. You can find the database at: http://www.arrl.org/results-database?event\_id=27537

It's always fun to look at the statistics and compare VCARA scores with other stations, both comparable and non-comparable. The database can be tweaked for various readings. These are some of the scores from that list.

- There were 2632 stations reporting and VCARA was listed as 814th, as to high score.
- In the 2A category, out of 381 stations nationwide, VCARA was 176th in score.
- New Mexico reported 27 stations in Field Day, of which VCARA was 7th.
- In the NM 2A category, there were 4 stations reporting, of which VCARA was listed as 3rd.
- In the Rocky Mountain Division (NM, CO, UT, WY), VCARA ranked 34th out of 124 stations
- In the Rocky Mountain Division of 2A, VCARA was 8th out of 17 stations.

In the Participants column, VCARA was 24th nationwide, with 91 participants, getting beat out by 20 stations who had 100 or more participants. Top of that list was the North Fulton Amateur Radio League of Fulton, GA who had a whopping 269 people turn out for their FD! Would be interesting to know how many hamburgers they served. There were 5 clubs who had over 200 people. Will be hard for us to claw our way to the top of that list!

By the above stats, you can see that VCARA is always above the median...and this was a "down" year, with lots of hours where the radios were not being used. If there would have been a category of how much fun the clubs had, I'm sure that VCARA would be listed near, or at the top of that list! Mark your calendars for the last full weekend of June, and join us for Field Day 2012.

On November 8, 2011 at noon the National Emergency Alert System was tested. The plan was that every TV and Radio station would have message broadcast by FEMA. ABC news reported it that evening as a "blunder" as Lady Gaga music was planned in the background instead of the President of the United States. The following mornings Albuquerque Journal article "National Alert System A Bust of 1st Try" pretty much summed up the exercise. However, as we all know from our drills, exercises are meant to find the weaknesses in the system. While it was disturbing to find out that one Denver station lost audio for 2 hrs as a result of the test, one paragraph in the report brought a smile to my face. I quote "On the upside, the State Deportment of Homeland Security successfully completed a drill in which ham radio operators throughout the state helped disseminate an emergency alert" Good work guys! I would like to thank James McNutt KC7YWB (Valencia County EC) for lighting up the phone tree, taking the net, doing the roll call and making the contact to the State EOC.
