YOUR VERY OWN PERSONAL REPEATER

Have you glanced at a repeater directory, seen several VHF (2-Meter) repeaters scattered across New Mexico with the call sign NM5EM and wondered what the heck are these? Well, they can usually be used as your very own personal repeaters for you and your close buddies.

A few years back, somebody convinced the New Mexico State Legislature to appropriate a bunch of dollars to fund Amateur Radio VHF Repeaters across the state for use during emergencies.

These, like nearly all repeaters in New Mexico, are 'open' which means they can be used by any Ham. Most of these 18 non-linked, high-elevation repeaters are co-located or have essentially the same coverage as other open

repeaters, so for the most part they are superfluous and receive little use. But, they can be quite useful to a family or group who want their very own repeater without a bunch of folks monitoring their transmissions.

A couple of examples where you might find these useful are:

- When you are on your big ole ranch, you could use one of these to check-in or coordinate with your family, have the kids let you know the school bus is running late, etc... Hey, you could even use it to exchange sweet nothings with the cutie on the next ranch (so we are politically correct, 'cutie' is used here to refer to either sex). Just remember Amateur Radio's restriction of not conducting commercial business on Amateur frequencies.
- You are with a group hunting New Mexico's high-county elusive elk. All the licensed Hams in the party could communicate and coordinate their activities – "Hey, since you are back at camp, get a

You can find the list of the NM5EM repeaters by going to www.repeaterbook.com and searching for 'NM5EM' repeaters. Four cautions when planning on using these repeaters:

- 1. Have a backup plan since a few of the 18 repeaters are usually offline a November 2018 check found four were out of service.
- When you arrive, have every Ham check every radio to be sure they have the correct frequency, offset and tone, and each of them can actually reach the repeater.
 - 3. These repeaters are lightly used, so if you have an emergency you might not be able to use them to get help.
 - 4. And remember emergencies always have
