The Club's new Icom IC-7300 was the star of our regular October meeting. Charlie NM5CL arrived a bit early and got it warmed up and tuned into a DXpedition operating from Dulcie Island in the South Pacific. This is a rare DX country that was last activated about 15 years ago and considering the high cost and difficulty of the DXpedition probably will not be activated for another 15 years. WOW, what clear audio from the rig's digital processing! Ty K5WY was one of the club members who took advantage of the new rig before the meeting and worked the DXpedition including making a contact using the club callsign K5OUR.

The meeting program provided by Greg KG5OCW was a short instructive video of the IC-7300's features. While at first glance at



the rig's screen might make some think the rig would be complicated, the video showed it was relatively simple to use the touch screen to access all the controls, settings and features. None of the multiple levels of menus and sub-menus like the old IC-7000 we had. Later in the day we were able to go to the VP6D website and see our individual contacts were in the log.

After the meeting, Ty mentored a half dozen other club members to contact this rare DX entity. For some of us this was the first *split* contact we had made – Split means listening on one frequency and transmitting on another.

Come by the club shack some Saturday morning and try our out new IC-7300. Bring on our December Bethlehem Station, the 2019 NM QSO Party and Field Day 2019!
