REAL PROGRESS ON KC5OUR SHACK'S BUILDERS AREA

On Saturday, November 2nd eight club members departed our regular 9 AM Saturday get together at McDonald's for KC5OUR's Shack and begin building the Builder's area. A nice arrangement using some benches and solid core door table tops (from our old Rio Communities Shack) was developed. The arrangement not only will nicely accommodate the building and testing of radio equipment, but provides shelves and storage for test equipment and component storage as well as an area for license exams and

some table seating for such club activities as the waffle breakfast.

Chris W5CSG, Earl KB5UEW, Steve AC8PC and Charlie NM5CL getting a good start on the Builders Area benches and shelves. While the shelf above the bench is not shown in this photo, the pieces were cut for installation of the shelves planned for the following Saturday. While not shown in the photos, Ralph NM5RC stood around, watched and occasionally passed along a tool or pencil.

While the Builders Area was being built, Ty K5WY, Gene KI5BZI, Al KI5CUX (not shown) and Charlie NM5CL were setting up some of the radios in the three KC5OUR operating positions on the tables and shelves completed the previous week. Behind Ty, you can see the window mounted custom cable pass-through panel Ty built. This panel allows for state-of-the-art common AC/DC grounding and RF bonding/grounding of all antennas and radio equipment.

The pass-through/grounding panel has lots of room for expansion and will also accommodate antenna rotor cables and repeater microwave cables.
