## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

Saturday, February 8, 2020 starting time 0900

## **WHAT**

- Through the efforts of W5CSG and W5CLG, an 8' X 14' heavy-duty 2000 +/- pound aluminum container with a high security door was donated to the club. It is now sitting just north our KC5OUR Shack. The container has two skid-beams running the 14' length.
- The container needs to be leveled before we can use it effectively.

### **WORK TO BE DONE**

- 1. Dig out some sand from along the high-side skid so one end of the container can be slid about 10" to its desired position. Move the container with a couple of long crow bars.
- o The loose sand in the area will be easy to dig, but will require kneeling down to work the shovel under the skid which is about 18" back

from the outside wall of the container.

- 2. Jack up and block up the container so it is level. Having the container level will allow us to measure between the bottom of the skids to the top of the composite planks on which the skids will rest so we are sure the 'base' is level.
- 3. Remove sand as necessary to place five evenly spaced 4"x8"x16" concrete blocks a constant distance below each skid. Place a 2"x6"x12' composite board on the concrete blocks under each skid and verify it is level for the entire length. Similarly place a concrete block topped with a 16" piece of composite plank under the end of each of the container's four fork lift lifting channels.
- 4. Lower the container onto 'base' and confirm the container is level front-to-rear and side-to side. If not level, jack up the low corner(s) and insert composite shims between a few of the concrete blocks and the plank and set the container back on the base.
- 5. Dig a 15" deep X about 20' long trench between the container and our club house building. This trench will be used for 1) a power line to the container and 2) a ground line from the building's power panel to the Shack's antenna entrance panel.

#### **HELP NEEDED**

• 16 VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!

- o 16 will get the job done in one day while allowing task distribution & rest periods.
- o All levels of abilities needed (i.e., everyone does not need to able to do 'knee work').

#### **BRING YOUR TOOLS**

- o Gloves
- Jacks: High lift jacks (like you see on the back of Jeeps), floor jacks
- Crow Bars: 6'+ heavy duty crow bars
- o Carpenter levels: 24" or longer
- Shovels: Short handled, square, army trenching tool, trenching, etc.
- Hoes & Rakes: 3 prong rakes, hoes, potting size spade, 3 or 4 tine potting size tiller, etc.
- Whatever else you think might be useful

SPECIAL NEED - Lots of pieces of 1X?s, 2X4s, 2X6s, 4X4s, etc. for the blocking. Please gather up all you can and bring them with you. Also, some pieces of plywood (or?) to can put under jacks.

size of this container is 7 1/2 feet wide, 8 feet tall, and 14 feet long (internal measurements.) This was a containment system for a low frequency high power auto tuner for the military in a past life. This container is a replacement for the 20 foot Conex container we used during the clubs move from the Rio Communities location to the current location in Los Lunas, and is much more fitting for a radio club. We need to get some of us together and level this container and plan out a way to secure it in place, something like drive anchors and cable or concrete piers with bolts and clips to the container to keep it from being tipped over by high winds. There is a good tie down point in 8 locations on the lower part of the box where the grounding straps were connected to the internal ground grid.

We also owe Mr. Ghoreishi a heartfelt thanks for the use of the 20 foot Conex during our time of need. Payam provided that Conex on short notice, and at no cost to the club at all. We used it for over 6 months for free and then when he needed it returned he found and provided this gem to us. We should come up with a good way

## Valencia County Amateur Radio Club Receives Walmart Grant

Los Lunas, NM, December 18, 2019 - The Los Lunas Walmart Super Center sponsored Valencia County Amateur Radio Association's successful application for a \$1,900 Walmart Community Grant. Every year Walmart awards thousands of grants for community service projects to non-profit organizations. Applications must be supported by local Walmart facilities to assure the fair distribution of grants across the nation and that local needs are met.

The Club will use the money to link its three open-to-all repeaters. Repeaters are similar to cell phone towers except they use radio waves rather than wires and repeaters continue to operate when electrical and/or phone service is disrupted. Using the linked repeater system, Hams (i.e., Amateur Radio operators) located anywhere in the County will be able to talk with each other. Club members using these repeaters are a key supplemental communications resource for Valencia County's first responders during large emergencies and for events such as the Good Friday Tome Hill walk.

The repeaters are also used for Ham-to-Ham visits and communication between family members. Using the repeaters' internet connection, local operators using a simple handheld radios are having a lot of fun to visit with other Hams around the world.
