PHASE 1 OF THE REWORK OF KC5OUR'S
VERTICAL HF
ANTENNA
ACCOMPLISHED IN
RECORD TIME ON
MARCH 13, 2021

Our vertical HF antenna was temporarily installed on the back porch with a few aerial radial wires. Not an optimum arrangement. About 12 club members gathered at the KC5OUR club 'Shack' on Saturday March 13 to start remedying the situation. After breakfast burritos, orange juice and coffee at 8:30, three crews tackled:

- Clearing the weeds off the site as well as most of the church's back yard.
- Laying out and staking the new antenna location and the thirty 32-ft radial wires.
- Digging a 44-inch deep 'post hole' and concreting in the pipe that will support the antenna.
- Taking down the existing antenna.

All done by 10 AM!

The antenna, radial wires and coaxial cable feedline to the shack will be installed on Saturday morning, March 20.

#### KC5OUR'S GROUNDING AND BONDING SYSTEM

With the vertical antenna rework done, our Shack improvement focus has turned to the grounding and bonding system GBS).

On Saturday, April 17, some of those who dropped by the club shack pitched in to complete the grounding system. With all the parts, pieces and tools gathered, the combined efforts of an 'inside crew' and an 'outside crew' efforts was soon celebrating the completion.

Special thanks to those who helped, supervised, designed and planned, and to those who otherwise helped.

Now, let's get KC5OUR on the air. If there is some event, or no reason at all, you can think of to activate the station, let an officer know and let's get it on the air.

A good GBS addresses three inter-related functions: Electrical safety, lightening protection and RF (radio frequency) control. The club has several copies of *ARRL's Grounding and Bonding for the Radio Amateur* books, which members can borrow. If you are setting up a

new station, want to review your station for safety or want to improve its performance, a careful reading of this book is highly recommended.

Here are a couple of tidbits that illustrate the importance of an integrated GBS:

• Ground here is not ground there - if you drive two ground rods say 100-ft apart and measure the potential between them, you will likely find some voltage difference between these two 'grounds'. This tells us that all ground rods and other 'grounds' (pipes, building structure, etc.) must be connected so there is only one path to

ground (i.e., you don't become the electrical path between two grounds').

Just because your equipment is 'grounded' (for example via three prong electrical plugs) does not mean the equipment is 'RF grounded'. Unless all your equipment is bonded together you may get a 'RF burn' when you touch two pieces of equipment. This bonding is accomplished by connecting the ground lug on each piece of equipment to a bus (copper pipe, grounding strap, etc.), which is in turn connected to the overall station ground. Doing this can also reduce the static and noise on your outgoing and incoming signal.
