New Business: Earl on the builders club

- The builders club is continuing the building of the audio switch. Earl in the process of developing and fabricating a circuit board for the project. There has been some delay in the autowire layout portions of the circuit board.
- The builders group is meeting the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month at the club house.They are also holding a zoom

meeting during the week as posted on the KC5OUR website.

John Schaff –

- A memorandum of understanding (MOU) is being drafted to obtain internet service through the schools district. The school service administrator has requested an internet traffic estimate from the club, and John suggested that 5Mbps would be needed during the weekday.
- Internet service from the church has been discussed. It would be expensive as it would be considered as commercial.

Chris –

 Provided a short discussion and description of QR-20 SDR Radio oddity radio that he has bought. This is a small form factor radio and it is capable of 20W transmit. Qugn (not sure of the spelling) is the original radio manufacturer The radio has a built-in battery pack. It covers 100 kHz through 2 GHz and includes a built-in auto tuner. Purchase price was ~\$699. (Earl has also purchased one

of these radios and spoke well of it.)

- Is anyone aware of someone who has a few commercial Motorola DMR repeaters for sale.
- Church members have presented the tower proposal to the ward leader for consideration and approval. The leaders are amicable to the proposal.
- Would need a tower/pole of about 35 feet with a microwave radio that can run at a level of up to 4W to

provide the internet connection to the school. There are a few trees in the line of sight path to the school that may impact the connection and

will present some level of attenuation.
