TOWER BASES TASK FORCE – NEXT PHASE

Hi Wonderful VCARA Members,


Now we have the concrete tower bases installed, we can move on the more exciting phases.

Saturday, May 14, 2022

➤ 120 VAC Power Line from Building to Shed - a small project. Starting work at 9 AM. Will be done before Noon. Donuts provided.

The work consists of:

- ➤ Trenching cleaning out, deepening a bit and shaving back the wall a bit on both ends of the ~30 of existing trench. The soil is soft, thus easy digging.
- ➤ Installing 1.25" PVC conduit with two horizontal-tovertical bends and LB junction boxes on top of risers; the boxes will be
 - connected to building and shed.
 - ➤ Install ~12' of ground wire from building grounding rod to shed entry panel.
 - Pulling power line through conduit.
 - Backfilling trench including laying down



➤ Digging 8-10 test holes along future trenches to verify type of soil – reason for this is to determine if the trenches could be easily dug by hand or if we are going to have to rent a trencher.

Tools needed: Please bring what you can.

- > Trenching shovels
- > Shovels
- Grubbing hoe/pick
- Probably not needed, but NM5RC will bring just in case
- ➤ 50' steel fish tape for getting pulling cord through conduits
- Might be useful if you have one, but we can get by without it
- ➤ Bolt cutter (or?) for cutting #6 ground wire
- Would be handy if you have one, but we can do this with the hack saw NM5RC is bringing
- Saws for cutting PVC conduit - NM5RC and W5CSG will bring

- ➤ Saw horses NM5RC will bring
- Drill w bits NM5RC will bring
