Discussion items:

• Insurance –

- No new developments on replacing the existing policy.
- ARRL offers a liability policy that the club is investigating. Cost is \$1.40 per \$100 of coverage.
- John S. will explore options.
- The current insurance policy is \$800 per year.
 The cost may cause the need for an increase dues and an increase in expenses.

• Antennas --

meeting. Facebook will make grant selection notifications in January 2023 and would provide funding in March 2023 for a successful grant application.

- Nick Carter is working the middle school principal to arrange for site surveys and coordination.
- The schools have pledged to provide books, cabinets, computers, and a meeting/equipment space.
- An elementary school has also expressed interest in having VCARA mentors provide help at their school.

Reimbursements from the W5YI testing sessions that the club sponsors throughout the year help fund the Christmas party prizes.

 There is a license exam testing session scheduled for October 8th at the club house. Testing includes a \$35 test fee.

Meeting adjourned at 7:33pm local time.

Presentation on QRSS was given by Earl Cox. QRSS is a digital transmission mode that transmits small messages over extended transmission times. This transmission mode if extremely low power and has

very small bandwidth requirements.

Narrower transmission bandwidths reduces the noise floor on and power necessary for a successful signal reception. Typically the slow data rates allow for transmission of callsign over about four minute times and can be achieved with typical transmit power of 200 mW for worldwide contacts. Mode transmissions are synchronized over 10 minute windows.

WA5DJJ has set low power Distance/Watt records for transmissions between Las Cruces and Florida. Earl displayed a small QRSS transmitter he designed and constructed on a surface mount development board that he mounted in a food can. He also handed out photos of other implementations of locally built transmitters from other ham operators. Because of the long transmission time, stable oscillators are required to prevent frequency drift. In Earl's transmitter, he implemented a simple temperature sensor that controlled heat generated in resistors mounted next to the crystal oscillator. This arrangement maintain the crystal at a constant temperature.

Signal reception for QRSS transmission occurs in distributed grabber nodes that operate around the world on specific frequency segments in the amateur radio bands. Reception is decoded by visually reading spectrum waterfall

displays that are generated by the grabbers. These displays are post over the world wide web.

QRSS transmitters can be easily home built from kits such as the Ultimate3/3S QRSS/WSPR kits from QRP Labs, https://www.qrp-labs.com/ultimate3.html.
